IMPLEMENTATION OF CLINIC

- 1 Create a child-friendly clinic by procuring:
 - infant scale
 - paediatric size equipment
- 2 Create required forms for clinic:
 - Referral for community partners
 - Immunization consent
 - Health history
- 3 Prepare the EMR:
 - Register all clinicians
 - Create required stamps
- 4 Develop schedules and train administrative staff on booking practices
- 5 Create and sanction Medical Directives:
 - RPN Immunization Administration
